(a) and (b): DoPPW has organized 11 Pension Adalats from 2017-2024 for redressal of long pending pensioners' grievances. In total, 25,224 grievances have been taken up in these Adalats, of which 18,005 cases were resolved, with an overall success rate of more than 71.38%. As per the annual work plan of DoPPW, it has been planned to conduct 3 Pension Adalats in 2024-25.
