VANDE BHARAT EXPRESS FROM NEW DELHI TO KATHGODAM

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is contemplating to start Vande Bharat Express from New Delhi to Kathgodam during the current Financial Year;
- (b) if so, the time by when the train will start running; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) to (c) Presently, 136 Vande Bharat train services are operating on the Broad Gauge (B.G.) electrified network of Indian Railways. At present, Delhi-Kathgodam sector is being served by 03 pairs of Mail/Express trains including the services of 12039/40 Kathgodam-New Delhi Shatabdi Express. Besides, introduction of Vande Bharat services is an ongoing process on Indian Railways subject to traffic justification, operational feasibility, resource availability, etc.
