SANITATION WORK IN SLUMS

†2761. SHRI ARUN KUMAR SAGAR:

Will the Minister of **JAL SHAKTI** be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Union Government has allocated funds to the State Governments during the last and current Five-Years Plan for undertaking sanitation work in slums, especially in backward and rural areas, for provision of basic facilities to the people in urban areas and other development works along with other schemes; and

(b) if so, the details thereof, State, date and scheme-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR JAL SHAKTI (SHRI V. SOMANNA)

(a) The initiatives under Swachh Bharat Mission-Urban (SBM-U) are targeted at benefitting the entire population of the urban areas including slums. Under SBM-U, funds are allocated and released to States/Union Territory (UT) Administrations for construction of Community/ Public Toilets (CT/PTs) and Individual Household Latrines (IHHLs) on need basis to all citizens of urban areas including slums. The Community Toilets (CT) and IHHLs are targeted for the underprivileged sections of the society who cannot afford these facilities. On the other hand, Public Toilets (PTs) are targeted for the floating population and common persons in public places in urban areas. Under the Solid Waste Management (SWM) component of the SBM-U, funds are released to the States/UTs for activities like Door-to-door collection of waste, source segregation and establishment of waste processing plants. Further, funds under SBM-U are allocated to States/UTs for entire mission period and not on yearly basis. The State/UT- wise details of funds allocation and released under SBM-U and SBM-U 2.0 are at **Annexure – A**.

(b) State-wise details of IHHL and CT/PT constructed alongwith status of Solid Waste processing are at **Annexure – B**. Details about solid waste plants are available at <u>https://sbmurban.org/swachh-bharat-mission-progess</u>.
