GREEN CORRIDORS

NO. 2875. SHRI UTKARSH VERMA MADHUR:

Will the Minister of Housing and Urban Affairs be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the scheme for setting up of Green Corridors in cities for the conservation of bio-diversity and to promote socio-economic aspects thereof; and
- (b) the details of the number of such Green Corridor cities, State-wise?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI TOKHAN SAHU)

(a) & (b) As per 12th Schedule of the Constitution of India, Urban Planning including town planning is the function of Urban Local Bodies (ULBs)/ Urban Development Authorities. Government of India supplements the efforts of the States through schematic interventions/ advisories.

The Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs (MoHUA), Government of India has issued Urban and Regional Development Plan Formulation and Implementation (URDPFI) Guidelines, 2014 (https://mohua.gov.in/upload/uploadfiles/files/URDPFI%20Guidelines%20Vol% 201(2).pdf). The Chapter - 5 "Urban Planning Approach" of URDPFI guidelines 2014 deals with Green City.

MoHUA is implementing Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT). One of the thrust area of the Mission is creation of pedestrian, non-motorized and public transport facilities. Under AMRUT, 323 Green Mobility projects have been completed to promote environmentfriendly mode of transport and infrastructure. The State-wise details of these projects are given at ANNEXURE-I. Further, AMRUT has led to development of 2,429 park projects worth ₹5,044.28 crore. The State-wise details of these projects are at ANNEXURE-II. Under AMRUT 2.0 so far, 1,729 Park projects worth ₹1,027.62 crore have been approved by MoHUA. State-wise details of these projects are given at ANNEXURE-III.

Under the City Investments to Innovate, Integrate and Sustain (CITIIS) 1.0 program, a sub-component of the Smart Cities Mission, a Green Mobility Corridor has been developed in Hubballi Dharwad, Karnataka. A grant of ₹115.68 Cr has been provided to Hubballi Dharwad Smart City Ltd for this project. The project focuses on the rejuvenation of the Unkal Nala, the 9.25kilometre-long drainage channel in the city, from being a mere stormwater drain to a developed, holistic space for the community. This corridor development also provides an opportunity for connecting the green corridor project to the major roads in the city passing through this Unkal Nala thereby creating a network of Non-Motorised Transport (NMT) corridors in the city.
