- (d) whether the Government has set any target for construction of National Highways in Uttar Pradesh in the coming years, if so, the details thereof?**

(a) and (b) The Government in the Ministry of Road Transport & Highways (MoRT&H) monitors construction length of its projects without making any distinction between old and new National Highways (NHs). The State/UT wise details of length of NHs constructed during the last 5 years, aggregated over various projects, including in the State of Uttar Pradesh is at Annexure-I.

(c) The State / UT - wise details of expenditure incurred towards development and maintenance of NHs in the country, including expenditure on land acquisition for NHs projects, during the last five years are at Annexure-II.
