- (a) the spurious drugs are openly available in the market across the country;
- (b) whether CDSCO recently found about 53 drugs to be of substandard quality as they all failed in quality test;
- (c) whether any action is being taken against all the said drug manufacturers;
- (d) if not, whether laxity in taking strict action against the drug manufacturers encourages the other manufacturers for such activities also; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

In cases concerning quality or safety of drugs as and when reported, action is taken by the licensing authorities concerned under the provisions of Drugs and Cosmetics Act 1940 and its Rules including prosecution in appropriate Court of law.
