TRAUMA CARE CENTRES IN CHHATTISGARH

3174: SHRI BHOJRAJ NAG:

Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of Trauma Care Centres in Chhattisgarh;
- (b) the amount of funds utilized by Chhattisgarh Government in this regard during the last three years;
- (c) whether any scheme is being implemented to provide emergency facility of Trauma Care Centre in Kanker district, a Naxal affected area of Chhattisgarh; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (d): Under the “National Programme for Prevention & Management of Trauma and Burn Injuries” (NPPMT&BI), 196 Trauma Care Facilities (TCFs) were sanctioned in Government Hospitals/ Medical Colleges across the country. Out of 196, 06 TCFs have been sanctioned in Chhattisgarh. The details of TCFs at Chhattisgarh along with unit cost are given below:

Beyond 12th Five Year Plan (FYP:2012-17), there is no provision of identification of new trauma care facilities under this Scheme. The financial support is in terms of release of the balance share of Central assistance within the total approved cost of the approved facilities/ units. As reported by Government of Chhattisgarh, no fund has been utilized during the last three years.
