**WORLD CLASS INFRASTRUCTURE IN PM MITRA PARKS**

- (a) whether the Government has taken any steps to promote integrated textile value chain under PM Mega Integrated Textile Region and Apparel (PM MITRA) Park Scheme;
- (b) whether the Government has approved any project to develop world class infrastructure in the said parks and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether any proposals have been received from Jharkhand and Bihar regarding setting up of said parks;
- (d) if so, the reaction of the Government thereto; and
- (e) if not, the Government proposes to set up the said parks in Jharkhand and Bihar by taking suo moto cognizance?

**(a) to (e):** To develop integrated large scale and modern industrial infrastructure facility for entire value-chain of the textile industry, the Government has approved setting up of 7 (Seven) PM Mega Integrated Textile Region and Apparel (PM MITRA) Parks in Greenfield/Brownfield sites with scheme outlay of Rs. 4,445 crore for the period 2021-22 to 2027-28.

All States including Bihar and Jharkhand were requested to submit proposals for setting up of PM MITRA Park from their States. In response, 18 proposals from 13 State Governments including one from West Champaran Bihar were received. No proposal from Government of Jharkhand was received.

The Government has finalised 7 sites viz. Tamil Nadu (Virudhnagar), Telangana (Warangal), Gujarat (Navsari), Karnataka (Kalaburagi), Madhya Pradesh (Dhar), Uttar Pradesh (Lucknow) and Maharashtra (Amravati) for setting up PM MITRA Parks.
