**Will the Minister of SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Government has implemented any scheme for non-profit organisations working for social welfare in the State of Chhattisgarh and the amount of financial grant sanctioned to them;
- (b) the total amount sanctioned to such NGOs in Parliamentary Constituency Durg during the last three years; and
- (c) whether the Government has any data regarding the number of persons benefited through these NGOs during the period, if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) to (c): The Department of Social Justice and Empowerment (DoSJE) is implementing two schemes namely National Action Plan for Drug Demand Reduction (NAPDDR) and Integrated Programme for Senior Citizens (IPSrC), a component of the scheme of Atal Vayo Abhyuday Yojana (AVYAY) for non-profit organizations working for social welfare throughout the country including Chhattisgarh. The details of funds released and number of persons benefited under these schemes in Chhattisgarh during last three financial years are at Annexure. Parliamentary Constituency wise data is not maintained in the Department.
