TRAINING IN SCIENTIFIC METHODS OF AGRICULTURE

- (a) whether the Government has provided any training in scientific methods of Agriculture;
- (b) if so, whether the farmers have been provided information in this regard; and
- (c) if so, the details of the districts where the said programme is implemented, State-wise?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE

(a) & (b): Yes, farmers have been provided information in scientific methods of agriculture under various schemes/programmes of this Ministry as per details given hereunder:-

(i) 'Support to State Extension Programs for Extension Reforms' (ATMA Scheme):

A Centrally Sponsored Scheme 'Support to State Extension Programs for Extension Reforms' popularly known as ATMA Scheme is under implementation across the country since 2005. Presently, 739 districts of 28 states & 5 UTs in the country are covered under the Scheme. The scheme promotes decentralized farmer-friendly extension system in the country. Under the scheme Grants-in-Aid is released to the State Governments with an objective to supplement the efforts of State Government in disseminating latest agricultural technologies among the farmers through training, demonstrations, exposure visits, kisan mela, mobilization of 'Farmers Interest Groups' and setting-up of Farm Schools in the field of progressive farmers.

The details of farmers benefitted under the Training component of ATMA Scheme during the last three years and current year is enclosed at **Annexure-I**.

(ii) Indian Council of Agricultural Research(ICAR) - Krishi Vigyan Kendras (KVKs):

The Indian Council of Agricultural Research is implementing Krishi Vigyan Kendras (KVKs) scheme in 638 districts of the Country through 731 KVKs with mandate of single window

agricultural knowledge, resource and capacity development centres. As part of its mandated activities, the KVKs provide training to farmers on various aspects of scientific farming in agriculture and allied sectors. The KVKs provided training to 21.56 lakh farmers during 2023-24.

(iii) Centre for Agriculture Technology Assessment and Transfer (CATAT):

Under this institute, farmers are provided need based training are organized through the State Government, private stake holders, Farmers Producer Organizations (FPOs), Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs) for the capacity building of farmers.
