CONSTRUCTION OF NATIONAL HIGHWAYS

- (a) whether construction of National Highways during 2024-25 is expected to slow down due to certain challenges being faced by the construction sector; and
- (b) if so, the detailed reasons for the same and the steps being taken by the Government to ensure that the construction of National Highways continues at the desired pace without any hindrance?

(a) and (b) Government has set a construction target of about 10,400 km during 2024-25 and achieved about 46% of the target up to November,2024. Challenges are being faced due to issues of land acquisition, encroachment removal, law & order, utility shifting, non-availability of soil/aggregate, environment/forest/wildlife clearances, ROB & RUB issues, contractual issues, etc. The Government in the Ministry of Road Transport & Highways is making all efforts to overcome the challenges, in coordination with State Governments, implementing agencies, and other stakeholders to achieve the construction target.
