#### IMPLEMENTATION OF MSMEs SCHEMES

#### 3988. SHRI VISHNU DATT SHARMA:

Will the MINISTER OF MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware that districts of Panna, Katni, Khajuraho and Chhatarpur are comparatively under-developed in industrialisation and employment generation in the secondary–tertiary sectors of economy;
- (b) if so, whether the Government has been implementing the schemes of Micro and Small Enterprises Cluster Development Programme (MSE-CDP), Scheme of Fund for Regeneration of Traditional Industries (SFURTI) and A Scheme for Promotion of Innovation, Rural Industries and Entrepreneurship (ASPIRE) in the said districts; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof including the status of project under the said schemes, outcomes achieved and timelines of execution and if not, the reasons therefor?

#### **ANSWER**

(a): Government implements various Central Sector schemes and programmes aimed at promotion and development of MSME Sector, thereby creating employment and economic Development of the Country including in the State of Madhya Pradesh. These schemes/ programmes include Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP), Credit Guarantee Fund Trust for Micro and Small Enterprises (CGTMSE), PM Vishwakarma (PMV), Micro and Small Enterprises - Cluster Development Programme (MSE-CDP) and Raising and Accelerating MSME Performance (RAMP), MSME Champions Scheme, etc.
