(a) to (d) Development of National Highway is a continuous process and Government regularly undertakes studies to assess need for the national highway/high-speed network development/ capacity augmentation to meet future demands. These efforts aim to achieve various objectives, including enhancing inter-state connectivity and reducing logistics costs. As of now, there is no proposal for development of Purakkatteri-Kuttiadi-Mananthawadi-Mysore Greenfield Highway.
