#### **QUANTITY OF FOODGRAINS**

#### 4044. DR. KIRSAN NAMDEO:

Will the Minister of *FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES* be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the quantity of foodgrains such as Fortified Rice Kernels, rice and wheat separately supplied during the last five years in the tribal and Left Wing Extremism (LWE) districts of Maharashtra;
- (b) whether there is any plan to increase the quantity of foodgrains in the aspirational districts and if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) whether any timeline has been set by the Government in this regard and if so, the details thereof?

#### **ANSWER**

## THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES (SHRI RAVNEET SINGH)

(a) to (c). As per the information provided by Department of Food and Public Distribution under Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution, the Government of India has started distributing Fortified Rice since the Pilot Scheme (2019-2022). The initiative was scaled up in phased manner (2021-24) and 100% coverage of distribution of fortified rice has been achieved by March, 2024. This initiative has been extended upto December 2028. The total allocation of Wheat and Rice from the Central Pool to the State of Maharashtra under various Central Government Schemes during last 5 years is as per ANNEXURE. The Targeted Public Distribution System (TPDS) is operated under the joint responsibility of the Central and State/UT Govt. Central Govt. is responsible for allocation and transportation of food grains upto the designated depots of the FCI. The operational responsibilities for allocation of food grains within the States/UTs, identification of eligible beneficiaries, issuance of ration cards to them, and distribution of food grains to eligible beneficiaries rest with the concerned State/UT Govt. The Central Government allocates food grains to States/UT Government. District-wise allocation is made by the concerned State/UT Government. States/UTs are being allocated around 46.253 LMT of food grains per month (approx. 555.04 LMT per annum). At present, against the coverage limit of 81.35 crore beneficiaries, State Governments have identified 80.67 crore beneficiaries. As and when requests are received from States/UTs for revision of foodgrains allocation under the Act on account of addition/deletion of new beneficiaries, within the ceiling of beneficiaries determined for that State/UT, the same are examined and revised allocation orders, are issued as per the extant policy.
