ESTABLISHMENT OF HOSUR AIRPORT

- (a) whether the Government has sanctioned the establishment of an International Airport at Hosur;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the details and status of the survey conducted by Airports Authority of India (AAI) for setting up of the said Airport?

ANSWER

(a) to (c): Government of India (GoI) has formulated a Greenfield Airports (GFA) Policy, 2008 for development of new Greenfield airports in the country. As per the policy, if any Airport developer including the State Government desires to develop an airport, they are required to identify a suitable site and get the Pre-feasibility Study conducted for construction of airport and submit a proposal to the Central Government for 'Site Clearance' followed by 'In-Principle' approval.

GoI has not received any proposal seeking its approval under Greenfield Airports Policy, 2008 for construction of a Greenfield Airport at Hosur, Tamil Nadu either from the State Government of Tamil Nadu or any Airport Developer.

However, on request of the State Government of Tamil Nadu, a multidisciplinary team of AAI and Tamil Nadu Industrial Development Corporation Limited (TIDCO) officials visited Hosur in Krishnagiri District in September, 2024, to carry out a Pre-Feasibility study of four proposed sites. Interim report thereof has been sent to State Government.
