(a) and (b) The Government in Ministry of Road Transport and Highways publishes annual report on "Road Accidents in India" based on data received from States/ UTs. As per the report for the year 2022, total number of road accidents on the National Highways (NHs) including National Expressways from year 2018 to 2022 is given in the table below:

| 2019 | 1,41,057 |
| 2020* | 1,19,615 |
| 2021* | 1,28,825 |
| 2022 | 1,51,997 |

Development and maintenance of National Highways is a continuous process. Works on NHs, including their capacity augmentation to four

six /eight lane NHs standards, are taken up based on the traffic density, condition of the roads, inter-se priority and availability of funds.
