ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SMT. ANUPRIYA PATEL)

(a) to (c) Under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) for "Augmenting Nursing Education - Establishment of new College of Nursing (CoN) in co-location with Medical College" 27 nursing colleges have been approved in the districts of Basti, Faizabad, Firozabad, Shahjahanpur, Bahraich, Etah, Hardoi, Pratapgarh, Fatehpur, Siddharthnagar (Domariyaganj), Deoria, Ghazipur, Mirzapur, Bijnaur, Kushinagar, Sultanpur, Gonda, Lalitpur, LakhimpurKheri, Chandauli, Bulandshahar, Sonbhadra, Pilibhit, Auraiya, Kanpur Dehat, Kaushambi and Amethi in Uttar Pradesh.

Further, funds of Rs. 54.00 cr as first installment towards Central Share have been released for establishment of 27 new nursing colleges in the above mentioned locations.
