AYUSHMAN CARDS IN DADRA AND NAGAR HAVELI

4306. SHRI PATEL UMESHBHAI BABUBHAI:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Ayushman Cards made for health facilities in the Union Territories of Dadra and Nagar Haveli, have a validity timeframe of 3 or 4 months only, if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and

(b) the manner in which the Government observed that the people avail the benefits of free treatment under the said scheme during the rest of the 8 months if the said cards are made for just 3 or 4 months along with the details of the hospitals and facilities extended for free treatment?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI PRATAPRAO JADHAV)

(a) and (b): Beneficiaries eligible under Ayushman Bharat - Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY) including those in Daman and Diu & Dadra Nagar Haveli can create their Ayushman Card at any time i.e. throughout the year.

The UT of Daman and Diu & Dadra Nagar Haveli implements a separate co-contribution scheme, Sanjeevani Swasthya Bima Yojana, using AB-PMJAY ecosystem for residents other than those covered under AB-PMJAY (i.e. APL families) in the UT. This state- specific scheme is completely managed by the UT administration and has fixed a period for enrollment from February to April.

Treatment for AB-PMJAY beneficiaries is provided in all empaneled hospitals throughout the year. In addition, the UT provides free of cost treatment in the government hospitals for other patients.
