851. SHRI VIJAY BAGHEL:

Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of UG and PG medical college currently operating in the country, State/UT- wise, particularly in Chhattisgarh;
- (b) whether it is a fact that Jawaharlal Nehru Medical and Research Centre having 800 beds is operated by Bhilai Steel Plant under Durg Parliamentary Constituency and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether any proposal is pending with the Government regarding starting a UG and PG medical college in the said hospital;
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (e) whether the Government has any plan to open a medical college in such a large hospital and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SMT. ANUPRIYA PATEL)

(a) to (e): The Government has increased number of medical colleges in the country. There is an increase of 101.5% in medical colleges from 387 before 2014 to 780 as of now. The State-wise details of medical colleges in the country are at Annexure.

As informed by Ministry of Steel, Jawaharlal Nehru Hospital and Research Centre is a 860 bedded Hospital operated by Steel Authority of India Limited/ Bhilai Steel Plant under Durg Parliamentary Constituency. At present, no proposal for starting of a UG and PG medical college in the said hospital is under consideration.
