There are 3698 centrally protected monuments/sites in the country including monuments in tribal development blocks under the jurisdiction of Archaeological Survey of India (ASI). The conservation, maintenance and upkeep of these centrally protected monuments/sites is a regular process and is taken up as per the requirement and availability of resources. All the monuments/sites are in a good state of preservation.

The necessary conservation and maintenance works of centrally protected monuments/sites are attended to by following National Policy for Conservation, 2014.
