**Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:**

- (a) the current status of all projects under spiritual tourism circuits and PRASHAD scheme along with reasons for slow progress, if any;**
- (b) the details of funds allocated, released and utilised till date thereunder in different States particularly in Uttar Pradesh during the last three years, year-wise;**
- (c) the details of plans to develop comprehensive spiritual tourism circuits in the country, State-wise including Uttar Pradesh and Rajasthan, particularly connecting significant sites like Ranakpur Jain Temple and other sacred destinations in Pali district;**
- (d) whether any assessment has been conducted regarding the reasons for slow progress of PRASHAD projects in the country, State-wise including the said States, if so, the details thereof and steps taken to speed-up implementation;**
- (e) the specific initiatives taken to improve visitor facilities at sacred sites in the country, State-wise including above States; and**
- (f) the details of coordination mechanism established for prior clearances with temple trusts, local authorities and other relevant stakeholders in the country, State-wise including aforesaid States to prevent delays in spiritual tourism projects?**

**ANSWER**

**THE MINISTER OF TOURISM (SHRI GAJENDRA SINGH SHEKHAWAT)**

**(a) to (f): A Statement is laid on the Table of the House.**

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**STATEMENT IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (f) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO.\*232 ANSWERED ON 17.03.2025 REGARDING SPIRITUAL TOURISM CIRCUIT RAISED BY SHRI NABA CHARAN MAJHI AND SHRI P P CHAUDHARY**

**(a) and (b): The Ministry of Tourism through the ongoing schemes of 'Swadesh Darshan (SD)' and 'Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual, Heritage Augmentation Drive (PRASHAD)' complements the efforts of the State Governments (SGs)/UT Administrations (UTs) by extending financial assistance to SGs/UTs for tourism infrastructure development.**

**The development and completion of projects under the schemes depend on various factors like successful tendering process, capacity of state implementing agency, timely project planning and designing, submission of requisite documents etc. The details of the current status of the projects under spiritual tourism circuits of Swadesh Darshan scheme and PRASHAD scheme, including the details of funds allocated, released and utilised are given in Annexure- I.**

**(c): No proposal is under the consideration of the Ministry of Tourism to connect Ranakpur Jain Temple and other sacred destinations in Pali district. Receiving proposals from the State Governments/UT Administrations for financial assistance for tourism projects is a continuous process. The proposals received are examined with reference to the prescribed guidelines and financial assistance is extended for such projects subject to fulfilment of the stipulated conditions and availability of funds.**

**(d): The projects sanctioned under the above schemes are implemented by respective State Government/UT Administrations. The Ministry of Tourism regularly monitors the progress of project and also encourages**

**respective State Government/UT Administration to complete the projects in a time bound manner. In order to monitor and expedite progress of the projects and to guide the State Governments/UT Administrations, the Ministry of Tourism holds regular review meetings at different levels, including Central Sanctioning and Monitoring Committee and Mission Directorate meetings.**

**(e): Under the PRASHAD Scheme, the Ministry of Tourism takes initiatives to develop well- planned tourism infrastructure enabling tourist convenience, accessibility, security, cleanliness, and enhancing pilgrim experience. Some of the major components/interventions approved under the PRASHAD Scheme to improve visitor facilities at sacred sites includes Cafeteria, CCTVs for pilgrim safety, Amphitheatre, Foot-over Bridges, Parking, Signages, Façade Illumination, Tourist Amenity Centre, Tourist Information Centre, basic amenities such as toilets, dustbins, drinking water facilities, drainage & waste management facilities and other site development works such as benches, landscaping, flooring, railings, etc. The details of the various components sanctioned under the projects of the PRASHAD Scheme is given in the Annexure-II.**

**(f): The Ministry of Tourism consults various stakeholders, including the State Governments/UT Administrations, local bodies, temple trusts and concerned Union Ministries and other stakeholders while approving of the projects under the PRASHAD Scheme. The State Governments/UT Administrations are required to provide undertakings ensuring encumbrance-free land availability and other necessary clearances and provide commitments for the sustainable operation and maintenance of developed assets, as part of the Detailed Project Report (DPR).**
