- (a) whether the Government has begun rolling out the Jan Samarth Kisan Credit Card scheme in the five identified States;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the process for selection of States and regions within States for implementation of the said scheme;
- (d) whether the State of Andhra Pradesh is included in this pilot initiative; and
- (e) if so, the specific districts covered and the steps taken by the Government to ensure smooth access to farmers?
