Will the Minister of **AYUSH** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has set up Central Research Institutes (CRIs) in each State/UT across the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the quantum of funds allocated and released by the Government to set up CRIs along with its utilisation by the States/UTs thereof; and
- (d) the other steps taken/proposed to be taken by the Government to promote Private Research Institutes in the country?

## ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE (IC) OF THE MINISTRY OF AYUSH (SHRI PRATAPRAO JADHAV)

(a) to (d) A statement is laid on the Table of the House.

# Statement referred to in reply to parts (a) to (d) of Lok Sabha Starred Question No.308 due for reply on 21.03.2025 asked by Smt. Manju Sharma regarding "Setting up of Central Research Institute"

- (a)&(b) The details of Central Research Institutes (CRIs) and their Peripheral units established by different Research Councils under Ministry of Ayush in different States / Union Territories across the country are given in **Annexure-I**.
- (c) Funds are not allocated / released by the Government to the State / Union Territories for setting up of CRIs. However, the funds are released by the Government to the Central Research Councils viz. Central Council for Research in Ayurvedic Sciences (CCRAS), Central Council for Research in Unani Medicines (CCRUM), Central Council for Research in Yoga and Naturopathy (CCRYN), Central Council for Research in Homeopathy (CCRH) and Central Council for Research in Siddha (CCRS) for setting up and running of these Institutes and their peripheral units in various States / UTs across the country. Details of funds released to the aforesaid Councils and its utilization during the last three years are given in Annexure-II.
- (d) The Ministry of Ayush is implementing a Central Sector Scheme, namely, AYURGYAN since 2021-22 with the aim to support Research & Innovation in Ayush by providing Extra Mural Research activities and Education by providing academic activities, training, Capacity Building etc.

The Scheme has 3 components viz. (i) Capacity Building & Continuing Medical Education (CME) in Ayush (ii) Research and Innovation in Ayush and (iii) Ayurveda Biology Integrated Health Research (ABIHR) has also been added under the scheme from the FY 2023-24.

Under the Research and Innovation in Ayush and Ayurveda Biology Integrated Health Research component, financial assistance is provided to the Organisations / Institutions (Private and Govt. both) for promotion of research in Ayush system.

The details of funds released to the private Institutes / Organisations under the component of Research and Innovation in Ayush are given in **Annexur-III**.

The details of funds released under ABIHR component since its inception are given in **Annexure-IV**.
