- (a) whether the Government has data on the number of cases and related deaths due to Dengue, Zika virus, Chikungunya and Yellow Fever in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government is aware of the Project Wolbachia to control diseases like Dengue, Zika Fever, Chikungunya and Yellow Fever, etc., if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) whether the Government has any project in hand or has any plan to implement Project Wolbachia and if so, the details thereof?

(a) & (b) The reported number of cases and deaths due to Dengue, Chikungunya and Zika virus in the country during 2024 are as under:

No case or death due to Yellow fever has been reported so far.

(c) & (d) Wolbachia is considered to be an alternate method to control Dengue and Chikungunya. The Indian Council of Medical Research- Vector Control Research Centre (ICMR-VCRC) maintains Wolbachia transfected Aedes aegypti mosquito. It has carried out laboratory studies on fitness characteristics on these Wolbachia transfected Aedes aegypti. As reported by ICMR, no project has been undertaken for field release of Wolbachia.
