IMPLEMENTATION OF 'HAR GHAR JAL' IN KORAPUT AND JALANDHAR

*467. SHRI SAPTAGIRI SANKAR ULAKA: SHRI CHARANJIT SINGH CHANNI:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

(a) the total number of rural households in the Koraput and Jalandhar Parliamentary Constituencies as per the latest available data;

(b) the number of rural households provided with Functional Household Tap Connections (FHTCs) under the Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) – 'Har Ghar Jal' scheme in the said Constituencies since its inception in August 2019, year-wise;

(c) the number of rural households yet to receive FHTCs under the said scheme in the said Constituencies; and

(d) the total funds allocated, disbursed and utilized for the implementation of the said scheme in the said Constituencies since August 2019, year-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF JAL SHAKTI (SHRI C R PATIL)

(a) to (d): A Statement is laid on the table of the House.

Statement referred to in reply to parts (a) to (d) in respect of Lok Sabha Starred Question no. 467 for reply on 03.04.2025 regarding implementation of 'Har Ghar Jal' in Koraput and Jalandhar asked by Shri Saptagiri Sankar Ulaka and Shri Charanjit Singh Channi.

(a) to (c) Since August 2019, Government of India is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM), in partnership with States/ UTs, to make provision of tap water supply to every rural household of the country. Drinking Water is a state subject, and hence, the responsibility of planning, approval, implementation, operation, and maintenance of drinking water supply schemes, including those under JJM, lies with State/UT Governments. The Government of India supports the states by providing technical and financial assistance.

As reported by state of Odisha, there are 5,32,290 rural households in Koraput parliamentary constituency and tap water connections have been provided 3,96,592 rural households since the launch of JJM in Koraput parliamentary constituency leaving a balance of 1,28,649 rural households which are yet to be covered. The year-wise coverage in Koraput parliamentary constituency has been given below:

As reported by state of Punjab, all the 2,24,197 rural households in Jalandhar parliamentary constituency have been provided with tap water connections. Out of which, 99,542 rural households that were provided tap water connection after launch of Jal Jeevan Mission. The year-wise coverage in Jalandhar constituency has been given below:
