- (c) the time by which the construction of the Bypass road and RoB is likely to be started near Singheshwar Dham in Madhepura district, Bihar?

- (a) There are a total of 36 ongoing projects in Bihar in which 41 ROBs are being constructed.
- (b) The Government for National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) has sanctioned a total of 5 no projects in Bihar for the financial year 2024-25.
- (c) The Detailed Project Report (DPR) for the bypass road near Singheshwar Dham has been awarded. The decision regarding its construction, including the construction of the ROB, will be based on outcome of DPR, fulfillment of the criteria, requirement of connectivity, inter-se priority and synergy with PM Gati Shakti National Master Plan.
