# CONSTRUCTION OF BUILDING FOR TRIBALS IN DAMAN AND DIU

(d) if not, the reasons therefor;

(e) whether the said building has been handed over to the Department of Education under the name of Shiksha Sadan;

(f) if so, the details thereof along with the reasons therefor;

(g) whether the said building is likely to be handed back to the tribal community in the future; and (h) if so, the time period for the same and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) to (h): As per information provided by UT Administration of Dadra Nagar Haveli, Daman & Diu, approval for construction of Adivasi Bhawan in Daman has been granted by competent authority of UT administration from its funds vide dated 17.01.2014. Funds under Major Works of Public Works Department (PWD) was utilized to build the building. Work order was issued on dated 04.03.2016 and building was completed on 30.09.2018. The building has been constructed by PWD department for an amount of Rs.4,42,17,841.81. The building is being utilized by Education department for the welfare of student community including tribal people of the UT.
