**\*63. SHRI ANUP SANJAY DHOTRE:**

Will the Minister of AYUSH be pleased to state

- a) whether the Government has conducted any comprehensive study on the availability of medicinal/fragrant plants and herbs in the country and if so, the details and the outcome thereof, State/UT-wise;
- b) the steps taken/proposed to be taken by the Government for identification, documentation, conservation/ protection, cultivation, commercial exploitation and constant management of medicinal/fragrant plants and herbs in the country, State/UT-wise;
- c) the details of funds allocated/released/utilized thereunder during each of the last three years and the current year, State/UT and year-wise;
- d) whether the Government has received several proposals from various States and institutions to set up herbal gardens and if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise including Maharashtra along with the action taken by the Government thereon; and
- e) the measures taken/proposed to be taken by the Government for setting up of herbal gardens in the country, State/UT and location-wise?

**(a) to (e): A statement is laid on the Table of the House.**

**STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION  
NO.\*63 FOR 07<sup>TH</sup> FEBRUARY, 2025**

(a) Yes, The National Medicinal Plants Board (NMPB) has supported a demand and supply study through Indian Council for Forestry Research and Education (ICFRE), Dehradun, entitled “Medicinal Plants in India: An assessment of their Demand and Supply” by G.S. Goraya & D.K. Ved published in the year 2017. As per the study, the annual demand of herbs/medicinal plants in the country was estimated to be about 5,12,000 Metric Ton in 2014-15. As per the study about 1178 medicinal plants species are recorded in practices of trade, out of which 242 species are traded in high volume of more than 100 MT per annum.

The study was published in 2017 and is available on the website of NMPB i.e. ([https://nmpb.nic.in/sites/default/files/Projects/Medicinal\\_Plants\\_in\\_India\\_An\\_Assessment\\_of\\_their\\_Demand\\_and\\_Supply.pdf](https://nmpb.nic.in/sites/default/files/Projects/Medicinal_Plants_in_India_An_Assessment_of_their_Demand_and_Supply.pdf)).

(b) For identification, documentation, conservation/ protection and constant management of medicinal/fragrant plants and herbs in the country, National Medicinal Plants Board (NMPB), Ministry of AYUSH is implementing a **Central Sector Scheme on “Conservation, Development and Sustainable Management of Medicinal Plants”** aimed at providing project-based support for the following activities:

- (i) Research & Development.
- (ii) *In-situ* conservation / *Ex-situ* conservation.
- (iii) Livelihood linkages with Joint Forest Management Committees (JFMCs) / Panchayats / Van Panchayats / Biodiversity Management Committees (BMCs) / Self Help Groups (SHGs).
- (iv) Establishment of nurseries.
- (v) Forward and backward linkage in supply chain of medicinal plants (Integrated Component).
- (vi) Promotion, marketing and trade of medicinal plants produce.
- (vii) Information Education & Communication (IEC) activities like Training / Workshops / Seminars/ Conferences etc.

Earlier, Ministry of Ayush, Government of India had implemented “Centrally Sponsored Scheme” of National Ayush Mission (NAM) to promote the cultivation of medicinal plants since 2015-16 to 2020-21. Under ‘Medicinal Plants’ component of the National Ayush Mission (NAM) Scheme, market driven cultivation of 140 prioritized medicinal plants in identified clusters/zones was supported and implemented in a mission mode through selected State Implementing Agencies throughout the country. Ministry of Ayush has supported 56,305 hectare area under Cultivation of medicinal plants from the financial year 2015-16 to 2020-21. As per the scheme guidelines, the support was provided for:

- Cultivation of prioritized medicinal plants on farmer's land.
- Establishment of nurseries with backward linkages for raising and supply of quality planting material.
- Post-harvest management with forward linkages.
- Primary processing, marketing infrastructure etc.

The Year-wise Funds allocated for medicinal plants component under National Ayush Mission (NAM) scheme is given **Annexure-I**.

(c) The details of funds allocated/released under **Central Sector Scheme on “Conservation, Development and Sustainable Management of Medicinal Plants”** during each of the last three years and the current year, State/UT and year wise is given at **Annexure-II (A & B)**.

(d & e) Yes, National Medicinal Plants Board (NMPB), Ministry of Ayush, Government of India has received several proposals from various States and institutions to set up herbal gardens, in which total **29 project proposals has been received from Maharashtra, out of which 7 project proposals has been sanctioned.**

From financial year, 2021-22 to till date, National Medicinal Plants Board (NMPB), Ministry of Ayush, Government of India has received 623 project proposals of herbal Garden, out of which 118 project proposals of Herbal Garden has been sanctioned.

Presently, National Medicinal Plants Board (NMPB), Ministry of Ayush is implementing a Central Sector Scheme on “Conservation, Development and Sustainable Management of Medicinal Plants” under which there is a provision to provide project based support to various Government and Non-Government organizations to establish different types of Herbal Gardens viz. School Herbal Gardens, Institutional/ Public Herbal Gardens and Herbal Gardens of State and National Importance. The details of the project proposals approved /sanctioned for herbal gardens along with location is attached at **Annexure-III (A & B)**.
