- (a) whether the Government has sanctioned any grant/funds for Jharkhand, Haryana and Jammu and Kashmir for the Skill Development Programme during the last three years;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, district-wise;
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the number of youths provided training under the said programme in the said States/UT during the last three years along with the details thereof, district-wise?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (A) TO (D) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. *81 ANSWERED ON 10.02.2025 REGARDING 'FUNDS ALLOCATED FOR THE SKILL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME'

(a) to (d) : Under the Government of India's Skill India Mission (SIM) , the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) delivers skill, re-skill and up-skill training through an extensive network of skill development centres under various schemes, viz. Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), Jan Shikshan Sansthan (JSS), National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS) and Craftsman Training Scheme (CTS) through Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs), to all the sections of the society across the country. The SIM aims at enabling youth of India to get future ready and equipped with industry relevant skills.

District-wise details of number of candidates trained under PMKVY, JSS, NAPS and CTS Schemes of MSDE in the state of Jharkhand, Haryana and Jammu and Kashmir during the last three years i.e. upto 2023-24 are given at **Annexure-I**.

Funds are not released directly to the districts under above mentioned schemes. Funds under PMKVY and JSS scheme are released to implementing agencies for meeting the training cost as per prescribed norms. Funds under JSS scheme are released to Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs) directly. Under NAPS, the establishments are incentivized by way of stipend support. Day to day administration as well as financial control in respect of ITIs lies with the respective State Government/ UT Administration. Details of funds released for the states of Jharkhand, Haryana and Jammu and Kashmir, for implementation of the above mentioned schemes, during last three years i.e. upto 2023-24 are given at **Annexure-II**.
