SKILL DEVELOPMENT FOR OVERSEAS PLACEMENT OPPORTUNITIES

1009. SHRI BASTIPATI NAGARAJU:

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is implementing any scheme which is currently providing skill development courses or training to individuals for availing overseas placement opportunities;
- (b) if so, the number of individuals trained under such schemes, State and year-wise;
- (c) the details regarding the number of individuals placed, classified country, State and year-wise;
- (d) the details regarding the funds allocated, disbursed and utilized for training and placement of candidates; and
- (e) the steps being taken by the Government to extend assistance to individuals for availing said opportunities?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP

(SHRI JAYANT CHAUDHARY)

(a) to (d) Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) is implementing its flagship scheme Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), since 2015, for imparting skill development training through Short-Term Training (STT) and up-skilling and re-skilling through Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) to youth across the country. Through PMKVY, individuals can avail placement opportunities both domestic and overseas based on their acquired skills and certifications.

Under PMKVY, since inception to 31st December 2024, a total of 1.60 crore candidates have been trained/oriented. Placement opportunities have been facilitated to 56.88 lakh STT and RPL certified candidates under three versions of the PMKVY Scheme namely PMKVY 1.0, PMKVY 2.0 and PMKVY 3.0, of which 24.37 lakh candidates have been reported placed, which is around 43%. Under PMKVY, since inception till 31.12.2024, Rs. 11,215.68 crore has been released, of which Rs.10,513.13 crore has been utilized.

The Year-wise, State-Wise, and Sector-Wise details of number of candidates trained/oriented and placed under PMKVY are given at *Annexure I*. State-wise financial progress details of PMKVY are given at *Annexure II*.

Further, in light of Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) motto 'Surakshit Jaaye, Prashikshit Jaaye, Vishwas ke Saath Jaaye" MEA started its flagship program, Pre-Departure Orientation Training (PDOT) in 2018. Under this program, the emigrant going abroad for employment is given a free of cost 8 hours Orientation training in order to apprise him with the Dos and Don'ts of the country of employment, his rights and welfare measures made available to him by Government of India. There are currently 49 PDOT centres across India. So far 1,72,220 candidates have been provided PDOT Training.

The State wise details of Candidates trained and funds allocated/utilized, financial year wise along with details of Budget Allocation under PDOT head during previous financial years are given at *Annexure III*.

(e) MSDE has facilitated placement opportunities through initiatives like Rozgar Melas and Kaushal Mahotsavs, connecting candidates with employers. Since 2018, over 1,500 such events have been held till 31.12.2024, shortlisting 2.89 lakh candidates for jobs. Newage courses aligned with the NSQF, covering technologies like AI, IoT, Drones, and Blockchain, have also enhanced employability through On-the-Job Training (OJT) and employability skills.

Further, with the introduction of the Pre-Departure Orientation Training (PDOT) program in 2018 by MEA, emigrants are equipped with essential knowledge on the culture, language, and regulations of their destination countries, ensuring their safety and smooth integration abroad. The program also familiarizes participants with welfare measures provided by the Indian Government, such as the Indian Community Welfare Fund (ICWF), Pravasi Bharatiya Bima Yojana (PBBY), eMigrate Portal, MADAD Portal, Pravasi Bharatiya Kendras (PBSKs), and 24x7 helplines at Indian Embassies and Consulates.
