SETTING UP OF INDIAN INSTITUTE OF SKILLS IN THE COUNTRY

1107. DR. PRABHA MALLIKARJUN:

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to set up the Indian Institute of Skills (IIS) in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise including Karnataka;
- (c) the details of the funds allocated/sanctioned for the institutes;
- (d) whether the Government identified the locations for said institute in the Davanagere Constituency;
- (e) if so, the details thereof;
- (f) whether the Government is planning to set up these institutes under PPP model; and
- (g) if so, the details and the time by which these will likely to be set up?

ANSWER

(a) to (g): The Government of India approved setting up of Indian Institute of Skills (IISs) in PPP model at three locations in the country viz. Mumbai, Kanpur and Ahmedabad. These institutes are conceptualized to bring in the best in class infrastructure and facilities to meet the aspirations of candidates who enter the skill learning domain. As of now, there is no proposal for setting up of new IISs.

The Tata Education and Development Trust (TEDT) has been selected as private partner in respect of IIS-Mumbai and IIS-Ahmedabad through a competitive process. No bid was received for IIS-Kanpur. TEDT has set up a non-profit company i.e. Tata Indian Institute of Skills (TIIS) for the operation and management of IIS-Mumbai and IIS-Ahmedabad. Land for setting up of IIS at Mumbai and Ahmedabad was made available by the Government of India and Government of Gujarat, respectively and the running expenditure is met by Tata IIS. The first phase of IIS at Mumbai and Ahmedabad has been completed. There is no proposal under consideration for setting up of more IISs.
