**Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:**

- (a) the details of the most significant milestones achieved under the Smart Cities Mission (SCM) since its inception particularly in Chhattisgarh;**
- (b) the manner in which the said mission has improved urban infrastructure such as roads, water supply and waste management in the selected cities across the country, particularly in Bengaluru along with the benefits derived from it;**
- (c) whether the SCM has successfully completed and if so, the details thereof along with the Government's plan to expand smart city initiatives beyond the currently selected cities;**
- (d) whether the Government can provide an update on Bengaluru's SCM projects and their completion status;**
- (e) the details of the other towns and cities selected under the said mission across the country along with the details of developments occurred;**
- (f) the manner in which the Government plans to address challenges in smaller cities and ensure equitable distribution of resources for development, including sustainable development, citizen engagement and the integration of emerging technologies like AI and IoT for smart urban management particularly in Bengaluru;**
- (g) whether the Government has formulated any scheme to get rid of pollution in Singrauli Municipal Corporation in Sidhi Parliamentary Constituency being an industrial area; and**
- (h) whether there is any proposal to select and develop Singrauli Municipal Corporation under SCM and if so, the details thereof.**

**ANSWER**

**(a) to (e) Smart Cities Mission (SCM) was launched on 25.06.2015 with the aim to promote cities by providing core infrastructure and give a decent quality of life to its citizens through application of 'Smart' Solutions. The implementation of SCM at the City level has been done by a Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV). The mission followed an area-based development approach through retrofitting, redevelopment and greenfield development in 100 cities. This approach accounted for other projects in the selected area, from multiple funding sources like convergence with other Central and State Government schemes, Public Private Partnership etc.**

**100 cities have undertaken a total of 8,058 projects amounting to ₹1,64,368 crore, in the mission. As on 20.01.2025, 7,480 projects (i.e. 93% of total projects) amounting to ₹1,50,017 crore have been completed, as per the data provided by 100 Smart Cities.**

**Details of significant milestones achieved under various core infrastructure sectors of SCM is at Annexure-I. Under SCM, 3 cities, viz., Atal Nagar, Bilaspur, and Raipur have been selected from the State of Chhattisgarh. The details of the selected towns and cities, state-wise including the state of Chhattisgarh and Bengaluru, are given at Annexure-II.**

**The Central Government has a total outlay of ₹48,000 crore for the 100 cities under SCM. As on 20.01.2025, the cities have been able to claim central financial assistance of ₹47,425 crore (i.e. 98.8% of the total Central share allocation) as per the utilization of funds provided by them. The States/Union Territories are reported to have utilized ₹45,506 crore (i.e. 96% of the total Central share released). At present, there is no proposal under consideration of the Central Government to extend the existing SCM by including additional cities.**

**(f) MoHUA also regularly interacts with the States /Smart Cities through video conferences, review meetings, field visits, regional workshops at various levels to expedite the performance of the 100 smart cities / Urban Local Bodies including 45 cities with urban population less than 5 lakhs (as per the Census 2011) and handhold them for improving the same, wherever required.**

**MoHUA has a multi-level review structure to expedite the progress of projects under the SCM. At the National level, implementation is monitored by an Apex Committee headed by Secretary, MoHUA. At the State level, Mission implementation is monitored by the State level High Powered Steering Committee (HPSC) chaired by the Chief Secretary. At the City level, there is a provision for establishing Smart City Advisory Forum (SCAF) for all 100 smart cities to advise and enable collaboration among various stakeholders.**

**MoHUA has issued various advisories to the States and Project Implementing Agencies reiterating the importance of consultation process especially the participation of public representatives be scrupulously followed. Nominee Directors of MoHUA on the Boards of Special Purpose Vehicle monitor progress in respective cities on a regular basis.**

**(g) & (h) Singrauli city in Sidhi Parliamentary Constituency was not in the list of cities recommended by the State for selection under SCM.**
