(a) whether the Government has taken any steps to provide adequate Training for Communication Navigation Surveillance (CNS)/Air Traffic Management (ATM) Personnel at Civil Aviation Training College (CATC) Allahabad and four Regional Training Centers (RTCs) at Delhi, Mumbai, Chennai and Kolkata Airports; and (b) if so, the details thereof and the total number of CNS/ATM personnel got trained during the last five years?

(a) & (b): The Airports Authority of India (AAI) has taken significant steps to provide comprehensive training for Communication Navigation Surveillance (CNS) and Air Traffic Management (ATM) personnel through the Civil Aviation Training College (CATC) in Allahabad and Regional Training Centers (RTCs) located at major airports in Delhi, Mumbai, Chennai, and Kolkata.

The total number of CNS personnel trained during the financial years 2020-21, 2021-22, 2022-23, and 2023-24 are 1080, 349, 1513, and 1262, respectively. In the current financial year (2024-25), 2975 CNS personnel have been trained till date.

Similarly, training for ATM personnel has been imparted in various disciplines. The number of ATM personnel trained during the financial years 2020-21, 2021-22, 2022-23, and 2023-24 are 2008, 2265, 3535 and 3983 respectively. In the current financial year (2024-25), 3663 ATM personnel have been trained till date.
