### DEVELOPMENT OF CLUSTERS FOR MSMEs

#### 1505. SHRI RADHESHYAM RATHIYA:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has adopted cluster development approach for the overall development of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the criteria fixed for selection of locations for the said purpose;
- (c) the details of MSME clusters proposed in Chhattisgarh along with the details of the functional clusters;
- (d) whether the Government proposes to set up such clusters in industrially backward districts of Chhattisgarh, viz. Raigarh, Jashpur and Kunkuri; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

#### ANSWER

# MINISTER OF STATE MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES (SUSHRI SHOBHA KARANDLAJE)

- (a) & (b): Ministry of MSME is implementing Micro and Small Enterprises Cluster Development Programme (MSE-CDP) across the country. The objective of the scheme is to enhance the productivity and competitiveness of Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) for their holistic development adopting cluster development approach by extending financial assistance as Gol grant to establish Common Facility Centers (CFCs) in the existing clusters and establish/upgrade infrastructural facilities in new/existing industrial estates/areas/flatted factory complexes. This is *Central Sector Scheme* and proposals under the scheme are received from the State/UT Governments to address the common needs of existing cluster in their States/UTs.
