#### TECHNOLOGY UPGRADATION IN MSMES SECTOR

#### 1529. SHRI ARVIND DHARMAPURI:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) the steps being taken by the Government in order to promote technology upgradation in MSMEs sector across States particularly in Telangana;
- (b) whether any subsidy is being provided by the Government to the MSMEs to boost exports;
- (c) if so, the details thereof along with total budget allocated and utilized since the inception of the scheme, State/UT-wise;
- (d) the impact of these subsidies on improving MSME productivity and competitiveness; and
- (e) the details on the adoption rate upgraded technologies among MSMEs?

#### **ANSWER**

# MINISTER OF STATE FOR MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES (SUSHRI SHOBHA KARANDLAJE)

- (a): In order to promote technology upgradation in MSMEs sector, Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) is implementing various Schemes which inter-alia include MSE-Cluster Development Programme (Common Facility Centres), Tool Rooms / Technology Centres, Micro and Small Enterprises (MSE) Green Investment Financing for Transformation (GIFT) Scheme and MSME Champions Scheme.
- (b): To boost MSME exports, Government has been taking the following initiatives :
  - i. International Cooperation Scheme of Ministry of MSME Provides financial assistance to MSMEs for participation in international trade fairs and exhibitions.
  - ii. Export Credit Guarantee Scheme (ECGS) of Ministry of MSME ensures easy availability of credit to exporters and reduces risks associated with exports.
  - iii. The Interest Equalization Scheme on pre- and post-shipments of rupee export credit has also been extended to the MSME Sector up to 31-12-2024, with a total allocation of Rs. 12788 crores.
  - iv. Assistance provided through several schemes to promote exports, namely, Trade Infrastructure for Export Scheme (TIES) and Market Access Initiatives (MAI) Scheme.
  - v. The Rebate of State and Central Levies and Taxes (RoSCTL) Scheme to promote labour-oriented certain items of textiles sector export has been implemented since 07.03.2019.
  - vi. The Remission of Duties and Taxes on Exported Products (RoDTEP) scheme has been implemented since 01.01.2021. With effect from 15.12.2022, uncovered sectors like pharmaceuticals, organic and inorganic chemicals and iron and steel articles have been covered under RoDTEP.

- vii. A Common Digital Platform for Certificate of Origin has been launched to facilitate trade and increase Free Trade Agreement (FTA) utilization by exporters.
- viii. Districts as Export Hubs initiative has been launched by identifying products with export potential in each district, addressing bottlenecks for exporting these products and supporting local exporters/manufacturers to generate employment in the district.
  - ix. The government has launched Trade Connect ePlatform on 11 September 2024. Trade connect ePlatform is an information and intermediation platform on international trade bringing together Indian Missions Abroad and officials from Department of Commerce and other organisations to provide comprehensive services for both new and existing exporters.
- (c) to (e): Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises implements International Cooperation (IC) Scheme which is a Central Sector Scheme. As per IC Scheme guidelines, funds are not allocated/released State-wise/UT-wise/District-wise; instead, funds are released for facilitating MSMEs through industry associations/organizations spread across the nation on reimbursement basis for participation in international events. The details of total budget allocated and utilized since the inception of revised IC scheme is as follows:
