Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) the total length of National Highways in Sikkim;
- (b) whether the Government has any plans to upgrade NH-10 to ease the traffic movement from Siliguri to Gangtok, if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the details of the National Highways existing in Soreng and Gayzing districts of Sikkim?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI NITIN JAIRAM GADKARI)

- (a) The total length of National Highways (NHs) in Sikkim is about 709 km.
- (b) Yes, sir. Government has taken up various works for upgradation of NH-10 to ease the traffic movement from Siliguri to Gangtok. The works those are taken up are as below:
 - i. 4/6 laning work from Balason Bridge (Siliguri) to Sevoke Army Cantonment.
 - ii. Detailed Project Report (DPR) for 4-laning of stretch from Sevoke Army Cantonment to Coronation Bridge (Sevoke).
- iii. Project Management Consultancy (PMC) for widening to 2-lane with construction of paved shoulders from Sevoke to Rangpo.
- iv. Preparation of DPR for widening to 2-lane with construction of paved shoulders from Rangpo to Ranipool.

- v. Performance Based Maintenance Contract (PBMC) from Ranipool to Gangtok.
- (c) There is no NH in Soreng District while there is 31 km of NH-510 falling under the Gayzing district of Sikkim.
