RELAXTION IN THE CRITERIA OF PMAY-U

NO. 1581. SHRI N K PREMACHANDRAN:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to relax the criteria for Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana - Urban (PMAYU) for providing houses to all deserving houseless families and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government has analyzed the fact that the existing criteria of PMAY-U is not suitable for the State of Kerala;
- (c) if so, the action taken by the Government to revise the criteria;
- (d) whether the Government proposes to conduct a survey regarding the houseless population in the country and if so, the details thereof;
- (e) whether it has come to the notice of the Government that the Central share under the scheme is not sufficient to meet the cost of construction;
- (f) if so, whether the Government proposes to increase the Central share by considering the price hike of building materials; and
- (g) the details regarding houses completed under the scheme during the last five years and the current year, State/UT-wise?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI TOKHAN SAHU)

(a) to (g): 'Land' and 'Colonisation' are State subjects. Therefore, schemes related to housing for their citizens are implemented by States/Union Territories (UTs). However, Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) supplements the efforts of States/Union Territories (UTs) by providing Central Assistance under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana – Urban (PMAY-U) since June 25, 2015 to provide pucca house to eligible beneficiaries in urban areas across the country. Based on the project proposals submitted by States/UTs, as on 03.02.2025, a total of 118.64 lakh houses have been sanctioned by the Ministry, out of which 112.46 lakh have been grounded and 90.36 lakh are completed/delivered to the beneficiaries across the country.

In the State of Kerala, a total of 1,33,488 houses have been sanctioned, of which 1,20,307 are grounded, and 97,823 have been completed/delivered to the beneficiaries under PMAY-U. State/UT and year-wise details of houses completed/delivered under PMAY-U during each of the last five years and the current year are at Annexure. The scheme period has been extended up to 31.12.2025 to complete already sanctioned houses without changing funding patterns and implementation methodology.

Based on the learning from the experiences of 9 years implementation of PMAY-U, MoHUA has revamped the scheme and launched PMAY-U 2.0 'Housing for All' Mission with effect from 01.09.2024 for implementation in urban areas across the country for 1 crore additional eligible beneficiaries.

As on date, 29 States/UTs have signed Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) to implement PMAY-U 2.0 as per scheme guidelines. There are estimated 4-5 lakh potential beneficiaries in Kerala but State has not yet signed MoA to implement the scheme.

The scheme guidelines have been prepared after consultation with States/UTs and a large number of other stakeholders. The funding under PMAY-U 2.0 is to provide a nudge to the beneficiaries and enable them to construct their houses by arranging funds from other sources as well. However, Kerala may provide enhanced State share as per PMAY-U 2.0 guidelines to reduce the burden on beneficiaries. There is no proposal to change existing criteria or Central Assistance for Kerala.

States/UTs/Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) have been asked to undertake assessment of housing demand under different verticals through suitable means for assessing the actual demand of housing on the Unified Web Portal of PMAY-U 2.0. The beneficiaries can also register themselves for housing demand with all the details on the portal. The scheme guidelines and Unified Web-portal for submitting the online applications can be accessed through https://pmay-urban.gov.in.
