Wages/Salaries to Cook/Staff under PM POSHAN Scheme

†1786. Shri Parimal Suklabaidya:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has paid the wages/salaries given to the cooks and other staff working in preparation of food under Pradhan Mantri Poshan Shakti Nirman(PM POSHAN) Scheme in Assam;
- (b) if not, whether the Government has any plans to make payment of such wages/salaries to these workers; and
- (c) whether there is any provision for making payment of wages/salary to the cooks and workers working under the scheme in other States, if so, the details thereof, State-wise including Assam?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (SHRI JAYANT CHAUDHARY)

(a) to (c): PM POSHAN Scheme is a Centrally Sponsored Scheme implemented in partnership with the States and UTs. The overall responsibility for smooth functioning of the scheme including providing hot cooked and nutritious meal to the eligible children as well as engagement of cook-cum-helpers (CCHs) lies with the State Governments and Union Territory Administrations. However, these CCHs are honorary workers who have come forward for rendering social services. As per guidelines of the Scheme, honorarium of Rs. 1000/- per month for 10 months in a year is prescribed for these CCHs in recognition of their services and the same is being continued. The honorarium expenditure is shared between the Central Government and States and UTs as per the approved sharing pattern, including the State of Assam. The State Governments and UT Administrations have the liberty to enhance the honorarium by providing additional funds from their own resources and some of the State Governments and UT Administrations supplement the honorarium by providing additional funds. The State of Assam has reported that the honorarium to CCH is paid upto February, 2025 under PM POSHAN Scheme. The details of honorarium provided to CCHs under the PM POSHAN Scheme by the States and UTs including Assam are given at Annexure.
