CONSTRUCTION OF ROADS IN KILOMETER UNDER PMGSY

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of length of roads in kilometer constructed under the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) in the country since its launch as on date, State and year-wise including Bihar;**
- (b) the amount of funds sanctioned, granted and spent by the Government on the said construction and improvement of roads so far, State and year-wise including Bihar and rural areas of Bareilly;**
- (c) whether the Government is aware that the quality of roads being constructed under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana in all districts of Bihar is very poor including Purnia district;**
- (d) whether the Government has allocated funds for improving roads under PMGSY in rural areas of Bareilly; and**
- (e) whether some of the States are unable to fully utilize the funds under the said scheme State/UT and year-wise and if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?**

**ANSWER

(a): The details of road length constructed under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY), State-wise (including state of Bihar) &

year-wise, may be seen at omms.nic.in -> Progress Monitoring -> Financial Yearwise Achievement.

(b): The allocation of funds for implementation of PMGSY is based on the proposals received from the State/UT and depends, inter-alia, on works in hand, execution capacity of the State, and unspent balances of the previous release available with the State. The details of central share of funds released state-wise (including state of Bihar) & year-wise are given at Annexure-I. The state-wise & year-wise details of expenditure incurred (including state share) may be seen at omms. nic.in -> Progress Monitoring -> Fund Position Report Live.

Funds (central share) are released to the States/UTs as a whole and further, district/sub-district-wise funds distributions are done by the concerned States/UTs. The Ministry does not maintain district or region-wise details of funds released. The year-wise details of expenditure incurred in Bareilly district of the state of Uttar Pradesh are given at Annexure-II.

(c): PMGSY has a three-tier Quality Control mechanism for ensuring construction of quality road works and durability of road assets. Under the first tier, the Programme Implementation Units are required to ensure process control through mandatory tests on material and workmanship at the field laboratory. The second tier is a structured independent quality monitoring at the State level through State Quality Monitors to ensure that every work is inspected at initial stage, intermediate stage and final stage of the construction. Under the third tier, which is at the national level, independent National Quality Monitors are deployed for random inspection of ongoing, completed and maintenance stage road works to monitor quality and also to provide guidance of senior professionals to the field functionaries. Based on the periodic monitoring of quality of roads under the 3-tier mechanism, corrective measures, wherever necessary, are taken by the State Governments. Thereafter, the Action Taken Report (ATR) is verified on site by State Quality Monitors (SQMs). The State Quality Coordinator (SQC) then, examines the ATR and furnishes the compliance report. The monitoring of Action Taken Reports (ATRs) is done by National Rural Infrastructure Development Agency (NRIDA), which is a technical arm of the Ministry of Rural Development.

(d): As given in reply to part (b) above, the details of expenditure incurred under PMGSY in Bareilly district is given in Annexure II.

(e): Under PMGSY, the funds are released to States/UTs based on the demands received from them, which varies from time to time and depends inter-alia on the pace of expenditure on the ground, unspent balances available from the previous years and fulfillment of certain conditions as laid down in the programme guidelines.

States/UTs sometimes face constraints in completing the activities as per the finalized action plan due to adverse weather conditions, unavailability of raw materials, legal issues, forest clearance issues, delay in award of the works and in some cases security issues which result in under-utilization of funds vis-a-vis the allocation. Road construction progresses in stages and expenditure on length constructed would vary according to the stage at which the road is being constructed. The Ministry regularly reviews the situation of unspent balance in various review meetings with the States/UTs.
