# LOK SABHA UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 1869 ANSWERED ON 11/03/2025

#### **RECONSTRUCTION AND REPAIR OF ROADS UNDER PMGSY**

#### **1869. SHRI SANJAY HARIBHAU JADHAV:**

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of roads constructed under Pradhan Mantri Gram SadakYojana (PMGSY) in the country during the last five financial years, State-wise;
- (b) the details of budget provision made for reconstruction and repair of roads under the above scheme in Parbhani Parliamentary Constituency of Maharashtra during the said financial years;
- (c) the number of roads upgraded under the PMGSY-III in the said constituency during the said period;
- (d) the funds allocated and released by the Government for the said purpose in the said constituency, State-wise including Madhya Pradesh;
- (e) the number of roads likely to be completed in the said constituency by 2025-26, State-wise and the target set in this regard; and
- (f) the number of roads constructed in Maharashtra till the year 2024?

#### **ANSWER**

### MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI KAMLESH PASWAN)

(a): The details of roads constructed under Pradhan Mantri Gram SadakYojana (PMGSY) in the country during the last five financial years, State-wise, are at Annexure-I.

(b): 'Rural road' is a State subject. As per the programme guidelines of Pradhan Mantri Gram SadakYojana (PMGSY), reconstruction and maintenance of roads constructed under the programme is the responsibility of the State Governments. As PMGSY is a one-time assistance programme for construction of rural roads, there is no provision under it for re-construction and repair of roads.

As reported by the State, an amount of Rs.124.38 crores was made available & expenditure made for reconstruction and repair of roads in Parbhani Parliamentary Constituency during the last five financial years.

- (c): Parliamentary Constituency wise details regarding implementation of PMGSY are not maintained in the Ministry. Parbhani Parliamentary Constituency comprises Parbhani and Jalna districts. A total of 14 roads of 102.57 km length have been upgraded under PMGSY-III in these districts during the said period.
- (d): The funds for implementation of PMGSY are released to the States/ UTs on the basis of the proposals received from them, and depend, inter-alia, on works in hand, execution capacity and unspent funds with State. Further release of funds to the Programme Implementation Units (PIUs) at the district level is done by the respective State Governments depending upon the absorption capacity of the PIUs. The details of funds allocated and released to the States during last five years and current year, Statewise, including Madhya Pradesh is given at Annexure-II.

A total of Rs. 160.26 crore, including State share, has been spent under PMGSY III in Parbhani and Jalna districts.

- (e): The timeline for completion of projects sanctioned under PMGSY is March 2025. The details of balance works, State-wise, is given at Annexure-III.
- (f): A total of 6,390 roads of 30,323 km road length have been constructed under PMGSY in the State of Maharashtra till December, 2024.
