- (b) whether the Government propose to set up PM Mega Integrated Textile Region and Apparel (PM MITRA) Parks, Textile parks in Haryana, Jharkhand and Uttar Pradesh;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (d) various steps taken by the Government to attract investors towards textile business in Haryana particularly in Sonipat Lok Sabha Constituency, Jharkhand and Uttar Pradesh under which incentives and policy support are being provided or efforts are being made to propogate and promote investment and business activities alongwith the district-wise details thereof?

(a) to (c): Government of India to make the country a global hub for textile manufacturing and exports, has approved setting up of 7 (Seven) PM Mega Integrated Textile Region and Apparel (PM MITRA) Parks in Greenfield/Brownfield sites with world class infrastructure including plug and play facility with an outlay of Rs. 4,445 cr for a period of seven years upto 2027-28. The Government has finalised 7 sites viz. Tamil Nadu (Virudhnagar), Telangana (Warangal), Gujarat (Navsari), Karnataka (Kalburgi), Madhya Pradesh (Dhar), Uttar Pradesh (Lucknow/Hardoi) and Maharastra (Amrawati) for setting up PM MITRA Parks. These parks will enable the textile industry to become globally competitive, attract large investment and boost employment generation.

(d): The Government of India is implementing various schemes/initiatives aimed at promoting the textile sector pan India including Sonipat Lok Sabha Constituency, Jharkhand and Uttar Pradesh. The major schemes/initiatives include PM Mega Integrated Textile Regions and Apparel (PM MITRA) Parks Scheme which seeks to create a modern, integrated large scale, world class industrial ecosystem, which will help in attracting investments and boosting employment; Production Linked Incentive (PLI) Scheme focusing on Man Made Fibre & Apparel, and Technical Textiles to boost large scale manufacturing and enhancing competitiveness; National Technical Textiles Mission focusing on Research Innovation & Development, Promotion and Market Development, Skilling and Export Promotion; SAMARTH – Scheme for Capacity Building in Textile Sector with the objective providing demand driven, placement oriented, skilling program; ATUFS to incentivize technology upgradation and modernization through capital investment subsidy for eligible investment in benchmarked textile machinery; Silk Samagra-2 for comprehensive development of sericulture value chain; National Handloom Development Program and National Handicraft Development Program for end to end support for handloom and handicraft sectors etc.
