STATUS OF NAPS 2.0 IN ANDHRA PRADESH

Will the MINISTER OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state :

- (a) the current-status of National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS) 2.0 in Andhra Pradesh, including the total number of apprenticeships provided in the State, district-wise;
- (b) the number of employers and industries in Andhra Pradesh enrolled under NAPS 2.0 for apprenticeship opportunities;
- (c) the total number of apprentices that have completed training under the said scheme along with the number of persons absorbed into full-time employment in the said State, sector-wise;
- (d) the financial allocation and disbursement under the said scheme, including amount spent on apprenticeship incentives and the plans for further fund releases to expand apprenticeship opportunities in Andhra Pradesh;
- (e) the number of apprentices from the said State engaged in CPSUs/SPSUs and Central/State Government departments, year-wise; and
- (f) the total number of women apprentices who have participated in the said scheme in the said State and efforts made to increase their participation in traditionally male-dominated sectors?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP

(SHRI JAYANT CHAUDHARY)

- a) National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS) was launched in August 2016. The scheme was extended to continue as NAPS-2 from FY 2022-23. Under, NAPS 2.0, the stipend support by Government of India (GoI) is paid through Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) to the bank account of apprentices. The number of apprentices engaged in the State of Andhra Pradesh from FY 2022-23 till FY 2024-25 (upto 31.12.2024) is **52,964.** The details of district-wise engaged apprentices in the State of Andhra Pradesh are given in the Table I of **Annexure**.
- b) Apprenticeship training is conducted within an establishment/industry. The number of establishment/ industries in Andhra Pradesh which have engaged apprentices under NAPS 2.0 (FY 2022-23 till FY 2024-25 (upto 31.12.2024)) are **998.**

- c) The total number of apprentices who have completed training under NAPS 2.0 (FY 2022-23 till FY 2024-25 (upto 31.12.2024) in Andhra Pradesh are **28,582**. The details of sector-wise bifurcation of the apprentices who have completed training in the State of Andhra Pradesh is given in the <u>Table II</u> of **Annexure.** The scheme promotes apprenticeship training which is governed by the Apprentices Act 1961 and Rules thereunder. Accordingly, it is not obligatory on the part of the employer to offer employment to the apprentice on completion of the apprenticeship training period.
- d) The details of the fund released to the State of Andhra Pradesh is given below:

Under NAPS-2, the government share of stipend is released directly to the apprentices through DBT. Further fund release under the scheme in the FY 2025-26 will be based on the apprentice engagement by the establishments in the State.

e) The total number of apprentices engaged in Andhra Pradesh in CPSUs/SPSUs and Central/State Government departments under NAPS 2.0 (FY 2022-23 till FY 2024-25 (as on 31.12.2024)) is given below:

f) The total number of women apprentices engaged under NAPS-2 in Andhra Pradesh is **10,189** [from FY 2022-23 to FY 2024-25 (upto 31.12.2024)]. The monthly Pradhan Mantri National Apprenticeship Mela (PMNAM) which is conducted pan-India level in at 1/3rd districts of each State prioritizes the mobilization of women candidates. Moreover, during all stakeholder engagements, including interactions with States, Regional Directorates of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (RDSDE),Third-Party Aggregators (TPAs), a strong emphasis is placed on engaging female apprentices, across all sectors.
