Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to launch Namo Bharat trains to run between shorter distance cities/routes;
- (b) if so, the details of number of trains and routes to be made operational during the current year across the country;
- (c) the details of number of routes/cities identified for Namo Bharat trains in the State of Karnataka including Davanagere;
- (d) the time by which the routes in Karnataka would be operational; and
- (e) the details of the speed at which Namo Bharat trains will be running?

(a) to (e) With a view to provide faster service and better travel experience to the passengers, Indian Railways are operating Namo Bharat Rapid Rail service. The first Namo Bharat Rapid Rail service viz. 94801/02 Ahmedabad-Bhuj Namo Bharat Rapid Rail has been operationalised w.e.f 17th September, 2024. Besides, introduction of train services, including Namo Bharat Rapid Rail services, is an ongoing process on Indian Railways subject to traffic justification, operational feasibility, resource availability, etc.

However, as the Railway network straddles across State boundaries, train services are introduced, as per network requirement across such boundaries.
