### Will the Minister of TRIBAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of funds allocated, released and utilized in the country for Eklavya Model Residential Schools (EMRS) since their approval, State-wise;
- (b) the list of EMRS identified for upgradation, State-wise;
- (c) the details of funds allocated, released and utilized in financial years 2023-24 and 2024-25 for the upgradation of EMRS, State-wise;
- (d) the student capacity of each EMRS and the actual enrollment during the last five years across the country, State-wise;
- (e) the sanctioned strength and existing vacancies for teaching and non-teaching staff in EMRS across the country, State-wise;
- (f) whether the Government is planning to sanction/set up/develop infrastructure for new EMRS, especially in Davanagere district of Karnataka, Nilgiris and Salem districts of Tamil Nadu, Kakinada district of Andhra Pradesh and Aurangabad district of Bihar, if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; (g) the status of land acquisition for the construction of EMRS in Devanagere district and the expected time for its completion;
- (h) the steps taken/being taken by the Union Government to address challenges in operationalizing EMRS and ensuring quality education for tribal children in the country, especially in Tamil Nadu; and
- (i) whether any improvements have been made in scholarships, academic facilities and infrastructure under EMRS for tribal students, particularly in Bihar and if so, the details thereof along with the quantum of funds allocated and utilised for EMRS in the State?

#### **ANSWER**

## MINISTER OF STATE FOR TRIBAL AFFAIRS SHRI DURGADAS UIKEY

(a) National Education Society for Tribal Students (NESTS) has been established as an autonomous body under Ministry of Tribal Affairs for managing and implementing scheme of EMRS. Ministry releases funds to NESTS and NESTS further releases funds to States/ UTs/ PSUs/ Construction Agencies/ State Societies as per their requirements for construction of EMRSs and recurring cost for running of the schools.

Prior to 2020-21, this scheme was a component under Grants under Article 275(1) of the Constitution of India. All the EMRSs are managed through respective State Governments, State EMRS Societies supported by respective tribal welfare departments of States/UTs. Funds released by NESTS to States/ UTs for EMRSs during the last five years are as under:

NESTS releases Rs. 1,09,000/- per student per annum for recurring grant under GIA-General for running and maintenance of Eklavya Model Residential School (EMRSs). Fund under GIA-CCA (Creation of Capital Assets) is released as per requirement on the basis of physical and financial progress of construction of schools.

- (e) Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance has sanctioned a total of 52 posts per EMRS across the country. The posting of staff is done as per the highest functional class and number of section and hence all the 52 posts are not posted at class VI level. Many of the posts in EMRSs have been filled through EMRS Staff Selection Exam 2023. Postings have been given to 9075 candidates through ESSE 2023, conducted by NESTS. Further, engagement on guest basis have been done in many EMRSs as a stopgap arrangement, so that availability of teaching staff is ensured.
- Government has decided to establish 728 Eklavya Model Residential School (EMRS) in every block with more than 50% ST population and at least 20,000 tribal persons as per 2011 census. Accordingly, in addition to the 288 Old schools sanctioned under Grants under article 275(1) of Constitution, 440 new schools (cumulatively 728 EMRSs) are scheduled to be established in the blocks fulfilling the criteria which are approved by the Union Cabinet in 2018-19 and provision of suitable land by the State to enroll around 3.5 lakhs ST students. As on date, a total number of 721 locations have been approved out of which 477 schools have been made functional.

- **(g)** There are no EMRS approved in Devanagere district, Karnataka as no blocks of the said district meet the twin criteria for establishment of EMRS.
- (h) The Union Government, through the National Education Society for Tribal Students (NESTS) under the Ministry of Tribal Affairs, is committed to strengthening the Eklavya Model Residential Schools (EMRSs) to ensure quality education for tribal children across the country, including Tamil Nadu. To ensure quality education and holistic development for tribal students following facilities are being provided in these schools:

#### 1. Educational Infrastructure:

- o Well-equipped classrooms with modern teaching aids.
- Science and computer laboratories.
- o Libraries with diverse learning resources.

#### 2. Accommodation and Amenities:

- o Residential facilities for students and staff.
- Separate hostels for boys and girls with essential amenities like bedding, furniture, and hygiene facilities.

### 3. Sports and Extracurricular Facilities:

- o Playgrounds and sports equipment.
- o Facilities for extracurricular activities like music, art, and sports

### 4. IT and Digital Learning:

- o Smart classrooms for digital education.
- o Computer labs with internet access.

## 5. Holistic Development:

 Special emphasis on extracurricular activities, vocational training, and skill development programs to enhance the overall personality of tribal students.

## 6. Training Programs:

 Regular training programs for principals, teachers, and staff in collaboration with premier institutions like NCERT, NIEPA, NISHTHA, Amazon Future Engineer (AFE) Program, and CBSE to enhance teaching quality.

### 7. Competitive Exam Coaching:

 Coaching for JEE, NEET courses is being introduced in EMRSs to improve higher education opportunities.

#### 8. Value Education and Career Guidance:

- o Value education is imparted to encourage moral upliftment among students.
- o Career guidance and psychometric testing initiatives help students identify their potential, interests, and aptitude, guiding them toward suitable career paths.

#### 9. DTH-Based Education:

 Education is provided through DTH mode and a dedicated TV channel exclusively for EMRS students to enhance learning opportunities.

To operationalise the approved EMRSs, NESTS has empowered the State Societies to functionalise the schools till the completion of construction of school buildings. Further, to provide quality education in EMRSs across the country, NESTS through EMRS Staff Selection Exam has posted more than 9000 teaching and non-teaching regular staffs, selected through centralised recruitment.

Under new scheme, the Ministry of Tribal Affairs approved 01 EMRS at Yercaud block of Salem district. Currently the said EMRS is functional from other Govt. building. State Govt. has submitted proposal for 07 EMRSs for upgradation and the same has been approved by NESTS.

(i) There are significant improvement in infrastructure for new EMRSs includes classrooms, science and computer labs, library, sports facilities, separate hostels for boys and girls student, Kitchen and Dining, and staff quarters for principal and teaching and non-teaching staffs. To address infrastructure gaps in Old School, the Ministry of Tribal Affairs is providing ₹5 crore per school for upgradation as per guidelines.

The Ministry of Tribal Affairs has approved three EMRSs in Bihar. Out of these, two schools were sanctioned under Article 275(1) (Old Scheme) and are currently operational from their respective buildings. The third school, approved under the new scheme, is presently in the pre-construction stage.
