**Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:**

- (a) the definition of a Smart City under the 100 Smart Cities projects;**
- (b) the details of the funds allocated, released and utilized for the development of 100 Smart Cities across the country since the launch of the Smart Cities project including Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar district of Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh and Dadra and Nagar Haveli as on date, year and smart city-wise;**
- (c) the targeted completion dates for the development of 100 Smart Cities in Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh and Dadra and Nagar Haveli, city-wise;**
- (d) the reasons for the delay in the development of Smart Cities along with the details of their current status; and**
- (e) whether the works are being carried out as per the rules under the Smart Cities project and if so, the details thereof?**

**ANSWER**

- (a) As stated in the Smart Cities Mission (SCM) guidelines, there is no universally accepted definition of a Smart City. It means different things to different people. The conceptualization of Smart City, therefore, varies from city-to-city and country-to-country, depending on the level of development, willingness to change and reform, resources and aspirations of city residents.**

- (b) **The Central Government has a total outlay of ₹48,000 crore for the 100 cities under SCM. As on 04.03.2025, the cities are able to claim central financial assistance amounting to ₹47,538 crore under SCM, out of which ₹45,772 crore have been utilized. The State/UT/City/Year wise (as on 04.03.2025) details of allocation of central financial assistance, funds claimed by all 100 smart cities and utilization are at Annexure-I.**
- (c) **On the requests received from the States/ UTs, Government of India has extended the SCM up to 31.03.2025 for completion of its ongoing projects under the SCM.**
- (d) & (e) **As apprised by the Smart Cities, the challenges encountered in implementing smart city projects include, *inter-alia*, legal issues, delay in obtaining clearances from different departments, land acquisition, construction in hilly areas, challenges in vendor and resource availability in small & medium cities, centralization of decision making in few cities, utilization of full capacity of Integrated Command and Control Centres (ICCCs) with integration of all municipal departments and agencies, frequent changing and dropping of projects. Details of the current status of smart cities is at Annexure-II. All the projects have been implemented under SCM are as per the SCM Guidelines.**
