SEWAGE AND SEPTAGE MANAGEMENT IN KAVALI CITY

Will the Minister of Housing and Urban Affairs be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has proposed any project to provide Sewage and Septage management in Kavali city with an estimated cost of Rs.
 13.5 crores in Nellore district of Andhra Pradesh, if so, the details and the date of commencement thereof;
- (b) whether it is true that the said project is still going-on and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) if not, the reasons for delay along with the time by which the said project is going to be completed; and
- (d) whether there is any cost and time overrun of the said project and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI TOKHAN SAHU)

(a) to (d): As informed by the Government of Andhra Pradesh, under Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT), two (02) Sewage and Septage management projects worth ₹19.29 crore have been taken up in Kavali city. One project worth ₹13.49 crore is at implementation stage.
