### 2576. SHRI BASTIPATI NAGARAJU:

Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

- (a) the details regarding the number of forest area, nurseries and ecosystem restoration projects undertaken under National Mission for Green India (NMGI), year, State and district-wise including Andhra Pradesh;
- (b) the details regarding the number of village and community institutions strengthened such as Gram Panchayats, Joint Forest Management Committee under the Scheme, year, State and district-wise including Andhra Pradesh;
- (c) the details regarding the total funds allocated, released and utilized under the Scheme, since its inception year, State and district-wise; and
- (d) the number of community foresters supported under the Mission, year, State and districtwise including Andhra Pradesh?

#### <u>ANSWER</u>

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE (SHRI KIRTI VARDHAN SINGH)

(a) to (d) National Mission for a Green India (GIM) is one of the eight Missions outlined under the National Action Plan on Climate Change. It aims at protecting, restoring, and enhancing India's forest cover and responding to Climate Change by undertaking eco-restoration activities in the forest and non-forest areas. GIM follows landscape approach and implementation of activities are being taken up by Joint Forest Management Committees (JFMCs) in the approved landscapes. The implementation of activities were started in the FY 2015-16 and so far 155130 ha area has been taken up under eco-restoration activities in 18 States/UT including Andhra Pradesh. The detail of state-wise number of approved landscapes, number of villages covered, number of JFMCs involved, number of nurseries established and area taken up for eco-restoration under GIM is detailed in Annexure-I. The State wise and year-wise detail of funds allocated/released, utilized and overall eco-restoration activities taken under GIM is given in Annexure-II.
