- (a) whether the features of the recently proposed Credit Guarantee Scheme for eNWR-based Pledge Financing (CGS-NPF) are designed to provide holistic support to both small and large stakeholders in the agricultural ecosystem particularly in Hathras district;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

(a) & (b): As per the information received from Department of Food and Public Distribution, the prime objective of Credit Guarantee Scheme for electronic negotiable warehouse receipt (e-NWR) based Pledge Financing (CGS-NPF) is to encourage banks to extend pledge finance against e-NWRs to farmers and traders on agricultural/ horticultural produce stored in the Warehousing Development and Regulatory Authority (WDRA) registered warehouses.

This scheme is expected to increase the post-harvest finance and enhance credit flow to the farming sector, thereby avoiding distress sale and realizing better remunerative prices for the farm produce.

The scheme is applicable in all parts of India including Hathras district and all segments of population subject to guidelines of the scheme.
