### MSP LINKED PROCUREMENT AND DIRECT BENEFIT TRANSFERS

2963. THIRU ARUN NEHRU :

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण मंत्री be pleased to state:

(a) the total procurement volume under the Minimum Support Price (MSP) across key crops in 2025 in comparison to past years, State-wise;

(b) whether the percentage of farmers benefitting from MSP has increased in the past year, especially among small and marginal farmers and if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether the MSP linked procurement and direct benefit transfers helped in improving farmers' income security and if so, the details thereof;

(d) whether there has been increase in diversification of crops due to MSP and if so, the details thereof; and

(e) whether the use of technology has improved MSP implementation efficiency and reduced delays in payment to the farmers and if so, the details thereof?

#### ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE

(a): The State-wise procurement undertaken at Minimum Support Price (MSP) for key crops for 2024-25 comparing with 2022-23 and 2023-24 is at Annexure-I.

(b): Procurement operations of notified commodities are undertaken at MSP as and when the market prices of these commodities fall below the MSP during the peak harvesting season to provide remunerative price to the farmers in order to protect them from resorting to the distress sale of their produce. As such, the overall market forces respond positively to the intervention of the Government in organizing procurement operations of commodities at MSP. The details of the farmers who benefited from selling their produce at MSP under procurement operations during the last 20 years is given at Annexure-II.

(c): Yes, the procurement of key crops undertaken by the Govt. at MSP during the last 10 years over the previous 10 years has improved the income security of farmers and the details are at Annexure-II.

(d) : The increase in diversification in crops specifically due to MSP intervention is not measurable directly as it is dependent on various factors. However, the details of increase in area and production of pulses and oilseeds during 2023-24 over the year 2013-14 is given in the table below:

(e) : The various procurement portals developed by the procuring agencies have now been unified into Central Foodgrain Procurement Portal (CFPP) towards development of an application eco-system, wherein requisite information in respect of procurement is available at single source for monitoring and strategic decision making and to ensure uniformity and transparency. One Nation, One MSP through DBT" has been implemented across the country from RMS 2021-22 onwards. The prompt payment of MSP has been ensured directly into farmers' account. Only registered farmers are eligible to offer their stock for sale at the procurement centre after verification of their identity through AADHAR authentification. The DBT of MSP and MSP procurement have brought in improving farmers' income, crop diversification, responsibility, transparency and real time monitoring in the system.
