NEW RAILWAY LINE BETWEEN JABALPUR AND INDORE

†3082. SHRI DARSHAN SINGH CHOUDHARY:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of present status and progress of the new 342 km long railway line from Jabalpur to Indore via Gadarwara and Budhni under West Central Railways;
- (b) the total amount of funds allocated and spent so far for the said project; and
- (c) the target fixed for completion of the said project along with time by which the said project is likely to be completed under present circumstances?

(a) to (c): The new line work between Indore (Mangaliyagaon) and Budni (205 Km) has been sanctioned at a cost of ₹3261.82 cr. An expenditure of ₹948.37 cr. has been incurred upto March-2024 and an outlay of ₹1107.25 cr. has been allocated for this project for the year 2024-25. The work between Jabalpur (Gadarwara) and Budni (137 Km) has not been taken forward as both are already connected via Itarsi through existing network and there is no significant reduction in the distance between the two places.
